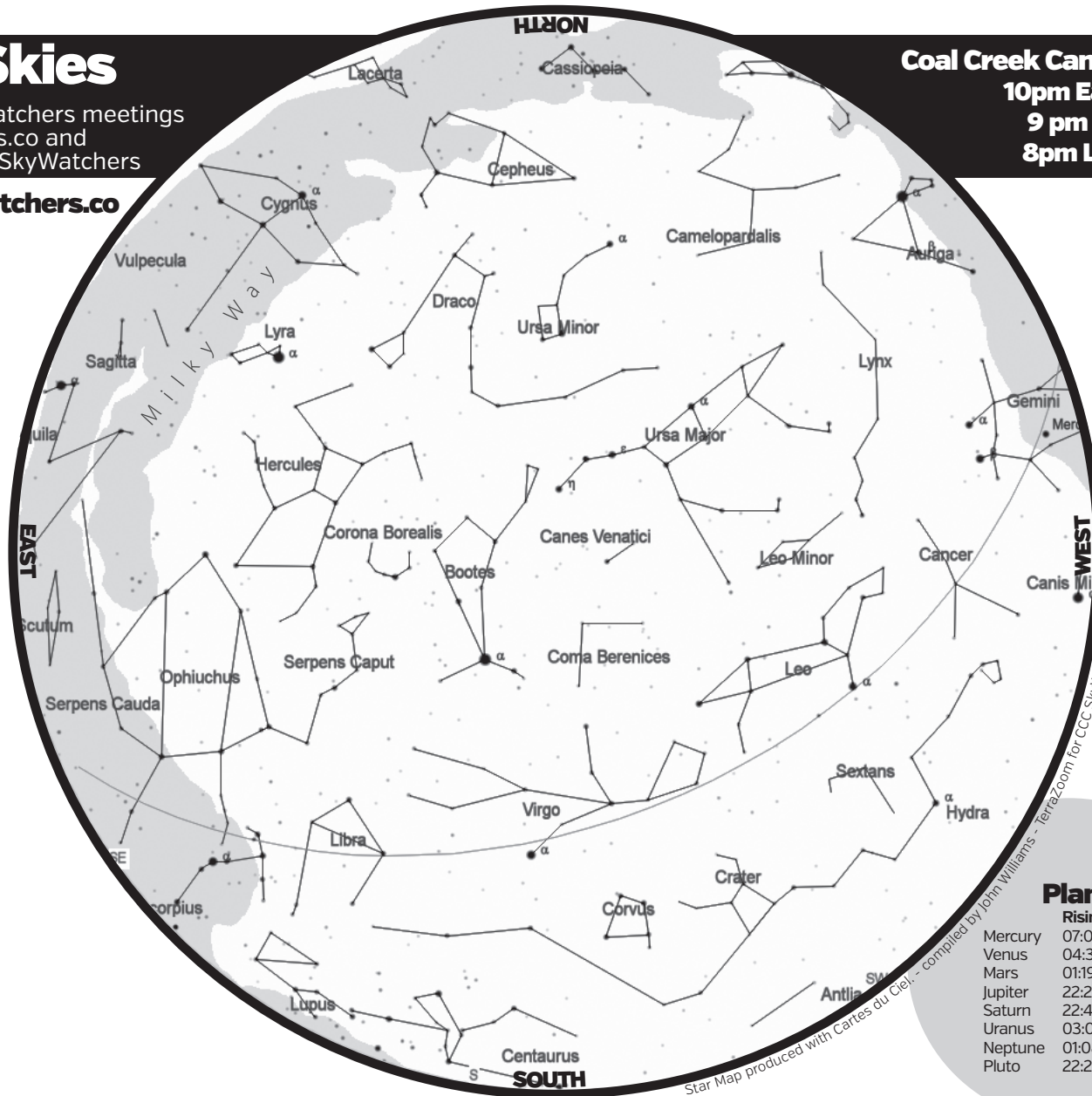
- 03 Venus at Inferior Conjunction
